Featured Saint: Pope Saint John Paul II



Karol Józef Wojtyła was born on May 18, 1920, in Wadowice, Poland, the youngest of three children. He as ordained on All Saints Day, 1 November 1946 and served as Pope 1978 to 2005. He was the first non-Italian pope in 455 years. At 84, He died on April 2, 2005, in the Apostolic Palace, Vatican City. He died on Divine Mercy Sunday, the feast day he initiated. He was buried on April 8, 2005, at St. Peter's Basilica where he remains. On May 1, 2011, Pope Benedict XVI beatified Pope John Paul II, and Pope Francis canonized him April 27, 2014. Oct

11, 1992 ordered the publication of the Catechism, had a role in the fall of communism, and was a Champion for the Culture of Life.

In 1917, our Lady of Fatima appeared to 3 shepherd children in Portugal 6 times May 13-Oct. 13. Her message was to pray the rosary daily to obtain world peace, to make reparation for sinners and consecration. She said, "More souls go to Hell because of the sins of the flesh than for any other reason."


