Featured Saint: St. Francis Xavier Cabrini

The dioceses in the US celebrate the memorial of St. Frances Cabrini, virgin, on Nov. 13. Born in Lombardy, Italy, one of 13 children she came to America as a missionary, founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart. In 35 years, she founded 67 institutions like schools and hospitals dedicated to caring for the poor, the abandoned, the uneducated and the sick. Seeing great need among Italian



immigrants who were losing their faith, she organized schools and adult education classes. As a child, she was always frightened of water, unable to overcome her fear of drowning. Yet, despite this fear, she traveled across the Atlantic Ocean more than 30 times. She died of malaria in her own Columbus Hospital in Chicago. She is the first American citizen to be canonized.

<u>Collect Prayer</u>: God Our Father, who called St. Frances from Italy to serve the immigrants of America, by her example, teach us to have concern for the sick, and all those in need, and by her prayers help us to see Christ in all the men and women we meet. Amen


Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Nov. 21st
